The singer/female active wear designer/world dominator is just one of many music performers that their songs turn into grindhouse movie posters. MusiXploitation is a series of movie posters that exist only in the hearts of furious fans. In the late 90s, Master P released full-length narrative films with the same names as his albums, which were like inventing lemonade predecessors with some serious dialogue. This new series is a glimpse into a world where this practice is caught with the entire music industry. Created by Paris-based artistic director David Redon, the series features blaxploitation-style posters of songs and albums by Amy Winehouse, 2Pac, and Jay-Z. (Previously Redon was mashed up by musicians with vintage ads.) Some are thematically appropriate, such as Frank Ocean's Galaxy, Spooky Pyramids, while others no doubt that their namesakes are as very upset as Lauryn Hill Miseducation turns into a bikini bank heist caper. As recent Quentin Tarantino book covers featured in Co.Create, some entries are marred by almost comically poor Photoshop.
